## Award Recipients

- Sen. Lamar Alexander (R-TN)
  - Lamar Alexander served as a Republican U.S. Senator for Tennessee from 2003-2020. Sen. Alexander held the position of Chair of the Senate Health, Education, Labor and Pensions (HELP) Committee from 2015-2020. Prior to running for Congress, Sen. Alexander served as the Governor of Tennessee and the 5th United States Secretary of Education. He announced his retirement from Congress in 2018.
- Rep. Nita Lowey (D-NY)
  - Nita Lowey served as the Democratic Representative for New York's 17th Congressional District from 1989-2020. In 2018, Rep. Lowey became the first woman to chair the House Appropriations Committee. Prior to running for Congress, Rep. Lowey held several leadership positions for the state of NY. She announced her retirement from Congress in 2019.
